

2017 Professional Board Requirements

Effective January 1, 2017

Tasked with raising funds and awareness of PAWS Chicago's lifesaving work, the Professional Board are role models in the community and a direct line from the animals into the community.

**To remain in good standing, members must complete all requirements as outlined below during each year of membership, including General, Fundraising and Event Requirements.*

General Requirements (all required):

- Pay \$250 yearly membership [dues](#) (Exception: If you join TEAM PAWS, your dues are waived for one year)
- Attend a New Volunteer Orientation (new members only)
- Attend 2 of 4 of the quarterly meetings
- Attend 1 of 2 of the group outings
- Make a 2-year commitment to the Professional Board

Fundraising Requirement (1 required):

- Become or recruit a lifeline donor to PAWS Chicago
- Plan your own fundraiser
- Create and fundraise for the December "We Give, They Live" campaign
- Join [TEAM PAWS](#) or recruit a new member to join [TEAM PAWS](#)

Event Requirement (1 required):

**Support 1 of PAWS Chicago's events by joining the planning committee and bringing in a \$500 value. See event planning committee details below.*

- Purchase 1 ticket for yourself or be an event sponsor
 - and 1 of the below
- Sell 20 raffle tickets
- Buy or sell additional tickets to the event
- Secure an event sponsor(s)
- Secure an auction item(s)
- Secure an in-kind donation(s)
- Secure or make a general event donation

PAWS Chicago 5K Committee (Event Day: TBD, Likely June 4, 2017 with ~ 4 meetings before event date):

- Register as a Lifesaver Participant or be an event sponsor
 - and 1 of the below
- Start a team of 5 or more
- Fundraise for the event
- Secure an event sponsor(s)
- Secure an in-kind donation(s) for the 'Hero Hangout'
